How do solar panels turn sunlight into electricity?

Do solar panels generate electricity during the day?

Solar panels require sunlight to generate electricity, so they do not generate electricity during the day. However, home solar systems typically generate excess electricity during the day, which can be stored in batteries or sent to the local grid in exchange for net metering credits.

Are solar panels a viable option for domestic electricity production?

Solar panels are appearing on more and more rooftops around our suburbs as solar photovoltaics (PV) become an increasingly viable option for domestic electricity production. How do solar panels work?

When we install solar panels, we are harnessing light energy from the sun. When the light strikes the surface of the semiconductor material, a reaction takes place, which converts the light energy into electrical energy. But since solar panels aren't 100% efficient, some of this light energy becomes heat.

How do solar panels generate electricity?

This process is constant: Over 500 million tons of hydrogen atoms are converted into helium every second, resulting in photons that generate solar energy here on Earth. In a nutshell, solar panels generate electricity when photons (those particles of sunlight we discussed before) strike solar cells. The process is called the photovoltaic effect.

How much electricity does a solar panel generate?

The electricity (or electrical energy) generated by solar panels is measured in watt-hours (Wh) or kilowatt-hours (kWh). Under 'standard test conditions', the most electricity that 1 kW of solar panels will generate in 1 hour is 1 kWh of electricity.
