Are solar stack roof mounting systems ul 2703 listed?

Solar Stack Roof mounting systems are UL 2703 listed. Standard for safety UL/ANSI 2703, Mounting Systems, Mounting devices, Clamping/Retention Devices and Ground lugs for use with PV modules. Solar Stack systems have been evaluated for module-to-system bonding and mechanical load to the requirements of UL/ANSI 2703.

Do I need to meter a photovoltaic system?

It is assumed that aluminum framed photovoltaic (PV) panels mounted on a "post" and rail mounting system, the most common in the industry today, will be installed by the homeowner. While metering the system is encouraged, the specification does not address system wiring elements for associated system sensors or monitoring equipment.

What are photovoltaic panels & how do they work?

They are designed for builders constructing single family homes with pitched roofs, which offer adequate access to the attic after construction. It is assumed that aluminum framed photovoltaic (PV) panels mounted on a "post" and rail mounting system, the most common in the industry today, will be installed by the homeowner.

What is included in a power rail PV flash?

POWER RAIL PV Flash includes one universal slotted compression block, and one 8" x 12" flashing in matte, black color. L-Foot ordered separately. *MUST order in quantities of 10. The all aluminum Low Profile Tilt Kits mount a set of POWER RAIL extrusions (sold separately) at the tilt angle specified.

What materials are used for mounting base brackets?

Mounting base brackets are fabricated from Series 6000 structural marine grade aluminum. 5/16" hardware included. 1/2" L Feet are fabricated from high-strength 3/16" aluminum and include a vertical slot for adjusting to irregular surfaces. 5/16" coated hardware included. 1/2" L Feet are fabricated from high-strength 3/16" aluminum.
