Where can a ground-mounted solar panel be installed?

Ground-mounted solar panels can be installed anywhere with good sun exposure and sufficient amounts of open space - a minimum of 350 square feet is usually required. Ground-mounted solar panels are also known as backyard solar panels, free-standing solar panels, and ground-mount PV systems.

Can you put solar panels on a roof?

Ground mounts are more common for certain types of solar systems, like off-grid setups. But they can be used by anyone if they have the space! There are other options if your roof isn't suitable for solar panels; you can also consider a solar carport, a solar patio, or even a solar tree!

Can solar panels be installed in a garden?

If a property has less than 30 square metres of land, ground-mounted solar panels can still be fitted in a garden, either to supplement the solar panels on the roof of the house, or to power sheds or garden lights. How do I install solar panels on a ground structure?

Mount your solar panels on the ground structure. Connect your solar panels to your inverter. Maintain your ground-mounted solar panels. For our scenario, we consider the following: System size: A 2.4kW solar system of 6 x 400W solar panels. Total installation time: 2 to 3 days, including the building of the ground structure and solar frame.

Are ground-mounted solar panels a good alternative to rooftop solar?

Ground-mounted solar panels are a great alternative for customers who want solar - but don't have a roof that's suitable for them. On top of being an alternative to rooftop solar, ground-mounted solar systems can be used on farms, in your garden, and more!

Can solar panels be used in a home?

Although they're commonly used for solar farms, they can also be used in domestic solar panel setups. Solar panels can either be mounted on a metal frame or fixed on a single pole - both of which are driven into the ground, or anchored with concrete for stability.
