The present installed capacity of solar energy is only 60% of the target.

To meet this surging demand, solar energy is the best form of energy to fulfill the energy needs of India and bridge the energy demand-supply gap. India has tremendous scope of generating solar energy.

Will India become a key market for solar energy?

A 25-year vision document by the government has targeted 85% of the power generation from renewable and green energy sources enabling India to become one of the key markets for solar energy with a huge customer base for solar applications.

Could solar power save India?

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has set a goal to generate 450 gigawatts of renewable energy by 2030 - five times the current capacity. If achieved, it also means that India would generate 60% of its electricity from non-fossil fuel sources by 2030, well beyond the 40% target in its Paris pledge. Solar could be India's salvation.

How to promote solar energy in India?

Government has taken several steps for promotion of solar energy in the country. These include: Standard Bidding Guidelines for tariff based competitive bidding process for procurement of Power from Grid Connected Solar PV and Wind Projects.

India is at the forefront of solar energy adoption, considering the challenges like the limited availability of natural resources needed for power generation, rising demand for power, increasing prices of fuels, distribution difficulties in rural ...
