How much does a rooftop solar system cost?

The cost depends on factors such as system size, location, and incentives available. On average, a residential solar system may range from \$15,000 to \$25,000, with solar incentives and tax credits decreasing the cost by 15-30%. How long does a rooftop solar system last? A well-maintained rooftop solar system can last between 25-30 years.

Is rooftop solar cost-effective?

Rooftop solar is increasingly cost-effective for home owners, business owners, and their communities. Reductions in technology prices, innovative financing, and growing networks of solar installers and financial partners all helped drive down the prices for household systems in the United States by 45% percent from 2010 to 2014 [2].

Are rooftop solar panels or battery energy storage systems worth the cost?

Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL) researchers are here to help. Homeowners must navigate a quagmire of complicated policies to determine whether the energy savings from rooftop solar panels or battery energy storage systems (BESS) are worth the high upfront cost.

How much do solar panels cost per square foot?

On average, solar panels cost \$8.77 per square foot of living space, after factoring in the 30% tax credit. However, the cost per square foot varies based on the size of the home. For example, the post-tax credit cost of solar panels for a 2,500-square-foot home is around \$20,000 for a rate of \$7.96 per square foot.

How much does a rooftop solar system cost in Washington?

A 7.5 kW rooftop solar system plus a 13.5 kWh BESS would cost \$46,322 on average in Washington to install without incentives. The state's largest utility, Puget Sound Energy (PSE), offers a TOU rate option, meaning prices are higher in the evenings and lower overnight, in the early morning, and on weekends.

How much does a solar panel upgrade cost?

Electrical panel upgrades: Not all homeowners need to get a new electrical panel when they go solar, but if you live in an older home or your breaker box is too small, you may need to get an upgrade. Depending on the project, an electrical panel upgrade for solar could cost between \$2,000 and \$3,000.
