

# How long can a small milk storage box be stored

How do you store boxed milk?

Location: Situate your boxed milk away from any sources of heat or light. Once a carton of shelf-stable milk is opened, it requires refrigeration. Place the open carton in the refrigerator and consume it within 5 to 7 days for best quality. Keep the temperature of the refrigerator below 40°F (4°C) to ensure safety and maintain freshness.

How should milk be stored?

Shelf-stable milk, such as UHT (ultra-high temperature pasteurized) milk, should be stored at room temperature, ideally below 85°F (29°C). The container should be kept away from direct sunlight and in a dry place until the expiration date. Post-opening, it must be refrigerated.
