What is a fixed adjustable photovoltaic support structure?

In order to respond to the national goal of "carbon neutralization" and make more rational and effective use of photovoltaic resources, combined with the actual photovoltaic substation project, a fixed adjustable photovoltaic support structure design is designed.

What rack configurations are used in photovoltaic plants?

The most used rack configurations in photovoltaic plants are the 2 V \times 12 configuration (2 vertically modules in each row and 12 modules per row) and the 3 V \times 8 configuration (3 vertically consecutive modules in each row and 8 modules per row). Codes and standards have been used for the structural analysis of these rack configurations.

How to optimize a photovoltaic plant?

The optimization process is considered to maximize the amount of energy absorbed by the photovoltaic plant using a packing algorithm (in Mathematica(TM) software). This packing algorithm calculates the shading between photovoltaic modules. This methodology can be applied to any photovoltaic plant.

How to choose suitable locations for photovoltaic (P V) plants?

The selection of the most suitable locations for photovoltaic (P V) plants is a prior aim for the sector companies. Geographic information system (G I S) is a framework used for analysing the possibility of P V plants installation. With G I S tools the potential of solar power and the suitable locations for P V plants can be estimated.
