Can I install solar panels on a concrete tile roof?

Can you install solar panels on a Spanish tile roof?

Traditional Spanish tile roofs are made from clay tiles - this can be a pricey material to install solar panels on, given the extra labor required, but it's still very doable for solar installers. Unlike traditional asphalt roofing, clay tiles are usually removed and replaced during a solar installation.

How do you install solar panels on a roof?

Your installer would temporarily remove the tiles, install the hooks underneath into the roof, then put the tile back over the mount, and rack the system from there. The second option is called a comp-out, where your installer will remove the tiles where you intend to put solar, then lay down composite shingle to install the array.

Solar panels can be installed on most types of roofs, but they are especially well-suited for tile roofs. If you have a clay tile roof, make sure to choose a mount that is designed for that type of roof. You'll also need to get a ...
