Can solar panels be installed with rigid foam?

Can I install a PV solar system with sprayed polyurethane foam?

If you currently own a home or building with a sprayed polyurethane foam (SPF) roofing system and would like to install a PV solar system, there are a couple of ways this can be done, however the best way is to re-spray the areas where the solar standoffs have been installed with SPF.

Should you install solar panels on your roof?

Despite being economical, the upfront cost of installing rooftop solar panels is still high.

How to choose a solar roof?

Solar rooftop panels are installed using solar mounts. Identifying the area for solar panel installation helps determine how many solar mounts you need. Also, while identifying the total rooftop area, you can specify the extent of shade-free area. Ascertain the endurance capacity of the roof, as the solar panels are bound to weigh heavy on it.

Yes, you can install over foam as that's how most commercial roofs are made, but it's not nearly as straightforward as bolting to rafters. They're just nervous about anything outside the norm on residential work and really, I ...
