How much does a home solar installation cost?

The faster the cost of electricity increases, the shorter your payback period and the greater your savings will be. Lower solar prices also drive shorter payback periods. Ten years ago, a home solar installation cost \$3.60/W according to the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. That's 31% more than what we see on EnergySage right now.

What are soft costs for a solar and battery project?

Soft costs include administration costs for the company, customer acquisition and marketing, system design, permits and fees for connecting to the grid, and labor for installation. Here's the NREL's latest soft costs breakdown of a solar and battery project:

How much does a 400 watt solar panel cost?

Today's premium monocrystalline solar panels typically cost between \$1 and \$1.50 per Watt, putting the price of a single 400-watt solar panel between \$400 and \$600, depending on how you buy it. Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.75 per watt, putting the price of a 400-watt panel at \$300.

How much does a 5000 watt solar system cost?

A fully installed solar system typically costs \$3 to \$5 per watt before incentives like the 30% tax credit are applied. Using this measurement, 5,000 Watt solar system (5 kW) would have a gross cost between \$15,00 and \$25,000. The price per watt for larger and relatively straightforward projects are often within the \$3-\$4 range.

What is a 'solar panel rate' scam?

This is a common scam used to gather personal data and/or trick people into signing long-term solar lease agreements that are far less favorable than owning solar panels. For example, in February 2023, a Facebook page called "Solar Panel Rate" ran multiple ads claiming Elon Musk was paying homeowners \$2,500 to test out new solar technology.

What is NREL's PV cost benchmarking work?

NREL analyzes the total costs associated with installing photovoltaic (PV) systems for residential rooftop, commercial rooftop, and utility-scale ground-mount systems. This work has grown to include cost models for solar-plus-storage systems. NREL's PV cost benchmarking work uses a bottom-up approach.
