Should you buy a shed or solar power system?

Sheds and solar power are a natural fit. Solar power is environmentally friendly, quiet and requires little maintenance once installed. Solar panels have no moving parts, so there's nothing to break (on that component, anyway). Reputable solar kits also come with warranties for the products and power distribution, sometimes as long as 25 years.

Can you put solar panels in an outbuilding?

If you have an outbuilding that isn't wired for electricity, it isn't good for much except storage. Add a solar panel system, though, and the space becomes much more useful -- without increasing your monthly utility bills. Photovoltaic power will let you transform an unused space into your own workshop, man cave or she-shed.

Does solar work everywhere?

Solar doesn't work everywhere. You can't put a solar panel under a rock and expect it to produce power. Neither can you place it in the shade. Ideally, solar needs a clear, unobstructed view of the sun for as many hours of the day as possible. In the northern hemisphere, that means solar panels should face south.
