

What is a photovoltaic mounting system?

Photovoltaic mounting systems (also called solar module racking) are used to fix solar panels on surfaces like roofs, building facades, or the ground. [1] These mounting systems generally enable retrofitting of solar panels on roofs or as part of the structure of the building (called BIPV). [2]

What are mounting brackets & rails for solar panels?

Mounting Brackets are the primary components that attach the solar panels to the mounting surface. They come in various types depending on the mounting surface (roof, ground, pole, etc.). Rails: Rails are long, horizontal structures attached to the solar panels using clamps. They provide a stable base for the solar panels.

Do I need to meter a photovoltaic system?

While metering the system is encouraged, the specification does not address system wiring elements for associated system sensors or monitoring equipment.

Know the thickness of your modules and pick the corresponding end clamps, mid clamps or cap strips for the finishing part of the install.
