What is a solar inverter?

A solar inverter or photovoltaic (PV) inverter is a type of power inverter which converts the variable direct current (DC) output of a photovoltaic solar panel into a utility frequency alternating current (AC) that can be fed into a commercial electrical grid or used by a local, off-grid electrical network.

Are off-grid PV inverters a good option?

Off-grid PV inverters represent a good power source in remote areas without the availability of a power grid. They may not be subject to utility codes and power quality standards, as there is no power grid to feed into. However, the function or efficiency of the solar panel could be impacted and its lifetime may suffer.

What is a solar string inverter?

Solar string inverters are used to convert the DC power output from a string of solar panels to a usable AC power. String inverters are commonly used in residential and commercial installations. Recent improvements in semiconductor technology is allowing for string inverters with high power density (from 10s of kW to 100s of kW).

What is a photovoltaic (PV) panel?

The solar panel or PhotoVoltaic (PV) panel, as it is more commonly called, is a DC source with a non-linear V vs I characteristics. A variety of power topologies are used to condition power from the PV source so that it can be used in variety of applications such as to feed power into the grid (PV inverter) and charge batteries.

What happens if you convert a solar panel to a DC inverter?

Converting a solar panel to a DC inverter can lead to premature aging of the solar panel due to superimposed high-frequency currents and leakage currents. Additionally, it can result in electromagnetic interference (EMI) radiated by the panels that may exceed regulatory limits. Upstream of the inverter on the DC side, these effects are less obvious but still quite serious.

Why do we need a solar inverter?

As PV solar installations continues to grow rapidly over the last decade, the need for solar inverter with high efficiency, improved power density and higher power handling capabilities continues to scale up.

To have a functional solar PV system, you need to wire the panels together to create an electrical circuit through which current will flow, and you also need to wire the panels to the inverter that will convert the DC power produced by the ...
