What are the different sizes of solar panels?

There are 3 standardized sizes of solar panels, namely: 60-cell solar panels size. The dimensions of 60-cell solar panels are as follows: 66 inches long, and 39 inches wide. That's basically a 66"×39 solar panel. But what is the wattage? That is unfortunately not listed at all. 72-cell solar panel size.

How big are residential solar panels?

Most residential solar panels are 1.7m tall x 1.0m wide (or 1.7 m²), with a maximum power output of around 330W. Solar panels also come with 72 solar cells, which are larger to accommodate the additional cells. They are around 30% larger than residential solar panels, measuring approximately 2.1m tall x 1.1m wide (or 2.3 m²).

How to find solar module dimensions?

In a table, you will find solar module dimensions usually given as length times width times height (L×W×H) in millimeters (mm) or inches (in). Consider height to be the same as depth (thickness). On a diagram, you can read the dimensions directly. They will be shown with double-headed arrows like this:
