

Should you work with a local solar installer?

As Sam Zuckerman of Maine Solar Solutions points out, one of the benefits of working with a local installer - especially one that is certified by a national solar company - is that they may be more familiar with local regulations and processes than a national installer.

How do I prepare for my solar installation?

Clear your driveway and the area around your electrical equipment prior to your installation date. This may include removing or trimming back trees or bushes to provide our crew safe access when on site. Ensure no other contractors or workers will be on site during your solar installation.

Are solar panels free?

Once your panels are paid for in full, your electricity is essentially free except for any excess electricity you purchase from the grid. As with owning your own home, you control your own property, but you are also responsible for it.

What should I expect during a energy consultation?

The consultation should involve a discussion of your annual energy needs and the type of system you are interested in. The representative might ask if you want a battery backup, so consider whether you want to live off the grid or still be grid-tied.
