

# Planting *Anemarrhena asphodeloides* and *Bletilla striata* under photovoltaic panels

Is *Anemarrhena asphodeloides* a perennial?

*Anemarrhena asphodeloides* is an evergreen Perennial growing to 0.5 m (1ft 8in) by 1 m (3ft 3in). It is in flower from August to September. The species is hermaphrodite (has both male and female organs). Suitable for: light (sandy), medium (loamy) and heavy (clay) soils. Suitable pH: mildly acid and neutral soils.

Where does *Anemarrhena asphodeloides* grow?

*Anemarrhena asphodeloides* - Bunge. Mountain woodlands [174, 200]. Exposed slopes and hills . Scrub, grassy slopes, steppes, sunny and sandy hillsides from near sea level to 1500 metres . E. Asia - N. China and Japan. *Anemarrhena asphodeloides* is an evergreen Perennial growing to 0.5 m (1ft 8in) by 1 m (3ft 3in).

Where does *Anemarrhena* grow?

Scrub, grassy slopes, steppes, sunny and sandy hillsides from near sea level to 1500 metres . E. Asia - N. China and Japan. *Anemarrhena asphodeloides* is an evergreen Perennial growing to 0.5 m (1ft 8in) by 1 m (3ft 3in). It is in flower from August to September. Is *Anemarrhena asphodeloides* edible?

1.3 Medicinal uses (Warning!) There are no edible uses listed for *Anemarrhena asphodeloides*. The root contains about 6% saponins. Saponins make an excellent soap, having a gentle cleansing effect on the skin and clothes without removing the natural body oils from the skin [K].

When should I repot my *Bletilla striata*?

Timing is Key: Divide or repot your *Bletilla striata* in late winter or early spring, just before the growing season starts. Gentle Handling: When dividing rhizomes, use a sharp, clean knife and handle the plant gently to avoid damage. Adequate Space: Give each division enough space to grow when replanting.

How to plant *Bletilla* orchid?

Whatever you use as your combination to plant *Bletilla* orchid, make sure it is rich in organic matter. A general guideline is to use a mix that consists of 50% organic material (such as bark or coconut coir), 50% inorganic material (such as perlite or pumice).

Unlike many orchids, *Bletilla striata* "Alba" (Chinese Ground Orchid) is an easy-to-care-for hardy terrestrial orchid. It produces small, cattleya-like, pure white flowers, 1 in. (2.5 cm). Borne in elegant racemes of 5-10 blossoms, they rise ...
