

Plc suddenly restarts and wind power is generating electricity

What happens if a PLC is shorted?

Not a common behavior, but it can happen. Most likely, you have a shorted device that gets activated upon PLC startup, a Q output gets enabled, some relay closes or valve gets power, and the 24V supply crow-bars briefly. Power dips and PLC stops. Output goes off. Power supply powers back up. PLC restarts. Q output turns on.

Why is my plc not working?

If the fault doesn't originate at the PLC, inspect the field devices wired into them. Problems with field devices are usually due to damaged circuitry caused by exposure to adverse conditions; moisture, vibration, heat, electromagnetic interference, chemicals, etc. Power Outages

How do you fix a faulty plc?

To resolve these, use the system diagnostics to determine the root cause of the problem and after which, carry out a total system check to determine the extent of the problem. If the fault doesn't originate at the PLC, inspect the field devices wired into them.
