Today's energy storage technologies are not sufficiently scaled or affordable to support the broad use of renewable energy on the electrical grid. Cheaper long-duration energy storage can increase grid reliability and resiliences that clean, reliable, affordable electricity is available whenever and wherever to everyone.

Should energy storage be a partisan issue?

Energy-storage technologies "are neutral as to the fuel source," Leah Stokes, a political scientist at the University of California, Santa Barbara, told me. They "can store any kind of power--clean or dirty." Storage may become a partisan issue if it begins clearly helping renewable energy to threaten fossil fuels.
