Should aquaculture use PV solar power?

On the other hand, the site of aquaculture is often off the national grid, e.g., for cage systems offshore or a long distance from the national grid. Can solar panels help a fish pond grow?

It also increases the weight and stability of the structure, and prevents soiling on the panels. In addition, Inseanergy uses a pump and bilge system to remove dirt and excess particles from the floating structures.

Can floating solar power fish farms?

Inseanergy, a Norway-based renewables developer, has built a floating solar platform for use in aquaculture projects. The SUB Solar system is installed on recycled fish-cage float rings and can be used in combination with onshore power supplies to reduce the need for diesel generators, which are traditionally used to power fish farms.
