### What is a building integrated photovoltaic (BIPV)?

It started feeding electricity to the National Grid in November 2005 Building-integrated photovoltaics (BIPV) are photovoltaic materials that are used to replace conventional building materials in parts of the building envelope such as the roof (tiles), skylights, or facades.

#### How a PV module is connected to a battery bank?

In a series connection, the positive (+) wire from one PV module is connected to another module's negative (-) wire. This wiring approach enhances voltage compatibility with the battery bank. In this situation, the connections are made by matching positive (+) to positive (+) and negative (-) to negative (-).
