The Lockers (originally named The Campbell Lockers) was a dance group formed by Toni Basil and Don "Campbellock" Campbell in 1971. Active throughout the 1970s, they were pioneers of street dance.

Which lockers have an even number of factors?

Almost all the lockers have an even number of factors, because almost every factor has a "buddy." For 48, the "buddies" are 1 and 48, 2 and 24, 3 and 16, 4 and 12, and 6 and 8. Which factors don't have a buddy? It's the ones where the buddy is itself. Take locker 64 as an example. The factors are 1, 2, 4, 8, 16, 32, and 64.
