



The photovoltaic panel cannot reach the optimal angle

What is the optimal tilt angle for solar panels?

The first number is the optimal tilt angle for your solar panels. This means my optimal tilt angle is 35° from horizontal. The second number is my optimal azimuth angle -- the direction I should face my solar panels -- expressed in degrees clockwise from north.

How does the azimuth angle of solar panels affect power production?

Also, the impact of the azimuth angle of solar panels on power production decreases as we move toward the equator. It is because the tilt angle of panels becomes very small near the equator. As a result, panels are inclined almost flat, and the direction of panels becomes less relevant.

What angle should solar panels be mounted?

Another factor to consider is your home's roof slope. The average American home ranges in pitch from 4/12 (18 degrees) to 9/12 (37 degrees). To find the optimal angle to mount your solar panels, take your base tilt from your latitude and subtract it from your slope. Let's take a look at some examples:
