



# Things to note when purchasing photovoltaic panel plugs

Are plug and play solar panels UL listed?

While the entire kit isn't UL listed, each individual component is (pg. 5), so you can rest assured these are all legitimate pieces of equipment that have been tested and deemed safe. Another plug and play solar company, Plugged Solar, sells a larger array of kits, ranging from a single 250 watt panel to large 5,000 watt systems.

How do I choose a solar panel for my home?

Homes with south, southeast, and southwest facing roofs are among the best candidates for solar panels. Finally, homeowners should consider the amount of shade near their roof and how that may impact the amount of sunlight hitting a panel. Factors like trees, neighboring homes, and other tall objects can impact the amount of sun your roof gets.

Should you buy or lease solar panels?

Yes. Some homeowners opt to lease the solar panel system rather than purchasing it. They pay a monthly fee for the energy generated, which can be significantly lower than the fees paid to your local utility company. When you lease solar panels, the solar company owns the actual panels and system.

Does plug & play solar need a dedicated circuit?

However, just like a traditional solar installation, plug and play solar requires an isolated electrical circuit to provide a similar level of safety. So, to create a dedicated circuit for your solar installation, nothing else can be powered using that same circuit. Plug&PlaySolar notes this requirement in their installation instructions (pg. 5):

Can you buy a plug and play solar kit online?

Actually, yes. You can go online and buy a plug and play solar kit from a few different companies, like the aptly-named Plug&PlaySolar. They sell small, single panel kits designed for both roof- and ground-mounting.
