How to protect solar panels from hail damage?

Temporary solar panel covers are one of the most effective ways to protect your system from hail damage. There are two types of covers for solar panels: hard shell and padded covers. A hard shell cover requires special mounting to keep the shell in place. The advantage of using this type of cover is that it does not absorb rain or moisture.

Should I Cover my solar panels during a hailstorm?

When a hailstorm is in the forecast, you can cover your panels to prevent damage. A hard shell covering provides the best protection against impact. Hard Cases protect the panels completely, taking the full force of hail stones or other weather events, leaving the solar panel beneath it.

Can hail damage solar panels?

Hail sizes exceeding 2 inches can damage solar panels. Moreover, some states may experience rare instances of exceptionally high hailstorms, recorded with an 8-inch diameter. Employing solar panel covers is a valuable defense against larger hailstones in hail-prone areas.

Can solar panels be installed in a hail storm?

Hail yes! You should consider installing solar panels on your home even if you live in an area that experiences hail storms. However, if you live in Texas, Colorado, Nebraska, Minnesota, or Illinois you should take extra precautions in protecting your solar panels.

Does solar insurance cover hail damage?

Hail storms occur between March and October. States that receive the most hail include Texas, Colorado, and Nebraska. Hail can damage the external surface AND internal components of solar panels. Not all solar panel warranties cover hail damage. Most homeowners' insurance provides hail coverage for solar panels installed on rooftops.

Can solar PV modules survive hail?

Historically, solar photovoltaic PV modules have survived the majority of hail events they have experienced. In areas that have experienced very large hail (greater than 1 " or 44 mm diameter), however, hail has caused significant damage to PV modules. Some measures can be taken to limit damage to PV modules.
