Do you need a license to sell solar panels?

Some states require businesses to obtain specific licenses to sell solar panels. If you solicit, sell, negotiate, or execute home improvement contracts for a licensed contractor, you may need to register with the Contractors State License Board (CSLB). What other licensing and registration requirements impact solar contractors?

What are the requirements for a solar contractor license?

The qualifications for a solar contractor license typically include meeting certain education or training requirements, having a certain amount of work experience, and passing a licensing examination. Specific requirements vary by state. Meeting those solar contractor licensing requirements isn't just a formality. It's the law.

Do I need a certification to install solar panels?

However, requirements differ by state. If you are thinking of adding solar panel installation to your skill set, learn what type of training you need in order to obtain the required credentials. NABCEP, or the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners, is one of the leading certifiers for solar panel installation.

Do solar installers need a license in Nevada?

Nevada law requires that solar energy system installers be licensed by the Nevada State Contractors Board. Contractors may be licensed under License Classification C-37 (solar contracting), or perform solar work under License Classification C-1 (plumbing and heating) for solar thermal installations. Do you need a NABCEP certification to install solar panels?

In some states, the certification is also a prerequisite for qualifying for a state solar contractor license. Lastly, some states require that a solar panel system is installed by a NABCEP-certified contractor for the system to be eligible for state rebate funds.

Do you need a license to install solar panels in Georgia?

Georgia doesn't have a specific state-level license to install solar panels. However, contractors working on solar projects in Georgia typically need to hold a valid contractor's license issued by the Georgia State Licensing Board for Residential and General Contractors.
