



# Which new energy storage funds to choose

Is energy storage a good investment fund?

Energy storage is still a nascent sector so there are only a few funds that invest solely in it. All three below are investments trusts and their close-ended structure - limited by shares rather than growing or shrinking with outflows - makes them more suitable for this kind of investing than an open-ended investment fund.

Which energy storage stocks are a good investment?

Albemarle is the top holding, followed by Tesla, so if you can't decide from the previous stocks, this fund is a good one-stop investment to play the pending energy storage boom. With more than \$1 billion under management and about 60 components, this First Trust fund is another interesting and diversified way to play energy storage.

What is the iShares energy storage & materials ETF?

The iShares Energy Storage & Materials ETF (the "Fund") seeks to track the investment results of an index composed of U.S. and non-U.S. companies involved in energy storage solutions aiming to support the transition to a low-carbon economy, including hydrogen, fuel cells and batteries.

Should you invest in energy ETFs?

Energy ETFs offer access to energy companies without having to pick and choose stocks yourself. If you want to be a little more selective with your investments, you can look for energy ETFs that suit your personal portfolio. For instance, if you're interested in sustainable investing, there are clean energy ETFs that focus on renewable energy.

Which energy stocks should you invest in?

The ETF to watch for this role is XLE. XLE targets a market-cap-weighted index of energy stocks drawn from the broader S&P 500 index. It is a top-heavy ETF, with ExxonMobil and Chevron weighing in at 23.3% and 17.7%, respectively.

What are some interesting energy storage ETFs?

Another interesting energy storage ETF is GRID, which is focused on alternative energy infrastructure companies such as power management company Eaton Corp. (ETN), industrial conglomerate Johnson Controls International PLC (JCI), and electronics and automation pioneer Abb Ltd. (ABB).
